If you find an ideal live-in Care Professional through our platform and have had that Care Professional in place for more than 90 days and wish to continue their services privately, we offer a "Placement Fee" of £750 + VAT. This allows you to continue with your chosen Care Professional without further involvement from us, while still benefiting from our initial support. Both you and the Care Professional can remain registered with Curam, so you can easily use the platform again if needed or to cover your Care Professional's holidays and breaks.



How Curam Can Simplify the Search and Reduce Admin

Care Professionals are paid for their work via Curam's payment system. As our Care Professionals are self-employed, they set their own rates based on the level of care they provide and their experience.

When you log on, you can post a job to establish availability in the area or simply browse carer profiles where care is required.



The invoicing, messaging and job posts are easily managed for multiple clients under one log in.

Key Considerations

Beyond the core costs of Care Professional's earnings, there are several other factors to consider:

Travel

You may need to contribute to your live-in Care Professional's travel costs, particularly if they're travelling from afar or during peak times. During an engagement, Care Professionals would expect to be reimbursed for travel, car parking tickets, fuel, etc., if they are transporting their clients in their personal cars. Please discuss this with your Care Professional as part of their service agreement.

Food


Shared meals can be a great way for Care Professionals and clients to bond. You can provide food for the Care Professional as part of the regular shop, or agree on a food allowance (typically around £50 per week) to allow them to buy their own food.

Care Professionals' Insurance

All Care Professionals introduced by Curam have self-employed care worker insurance provided by Curam once an invoice has been created, covering public liability, accidental damage to property, and personal injury. You can review the Care Professional's insurance documents upon request. Remember this is only valid on the Curam platform.
